

PRODUCT CARE

Every element of every piece undergoes painstaking iterative development in collaboration with hand-picked artisans and fabricators - each chosen for their technique and mastery. Metal elements, such as brass and copper, are machined or hand-hammered, and custom finished. Glass forms are mouth-blown and molded. Crystals are individually cut and polished. Aluminum structures are anodized in small batches to draw out beautiful satin finishes. Concrete bases are cast and then stained. These classic techniques result in pieces that are imbued with just enough hand-touched imperfection to make each one subtly unique and purposefully one-of-a-kind.

GLASS AND CRYSTAL

Glass and crystal can be cleaned by wiping with a soft damp cloth or glass cleaner with no additives. Only use fine cotton or extra soft cloths. Apply glass cleaner to a soft cloth rather than directly on to the fixture to avoid overspray that may damage other finishes.

CONCRETE AND STONE

Clean by using a dry or slightly dampened cloth. If soiled, use a mild soap with luke-warm water (nothing containing citrus). Wipe dry with a clean cloth to avoid water spots.

UN-LACQUERED METALS

Cotton gloves should be worn whenever interacting with wax sealed surfaces as the oil from people's skin will affect the finish. Clean by using a dry or slightly dampened cloth. Only use fine cotton or extra soft cloths. We recommend that tarnished metals be professionally cleaned.

LACQUERED METALS

Lacquered finishes will not patina or change over time. These surfaces are durable but should be treated with care as it is possible to chip, crack, or scratch the protective coating. Clean by using a dry or slightly dampened cloth. Only use fine cotton or extra soft cloths. We recommend that tarnished metals be professionally cleaned.

ANODIZED ALUMINUM

Clean by using a dry or slightly dampened cloth. If soiled, use a mild soap with luke-warm water. Wipe dry with a clean cloth to avoid water spots.
